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Dear Parents/Carers,

At Haslam Park Primary we take the safety of the children very seriously, this is also true when it comes to them using the computers and internet at school. We have been updating our e – safety systems in school and would like to tell you how you can help at home.

1. Do not let your child bring CDs/ DVDs or memory sticks into school, unless asked to by the class teacher.
2. Talk to your child about the importance of keeping personal information private and not accepting ‘friendship requests’ from people they do not know.
3. Remind your child that they must never agree to meet anyone they have met on the internet.
4. Remind your child about the dangers of cyberbullying and sending inappropriate messages.
