Please make sure that your child's PE kit is in school all week. Due to the weather, we may have to change our outdoor PE time.

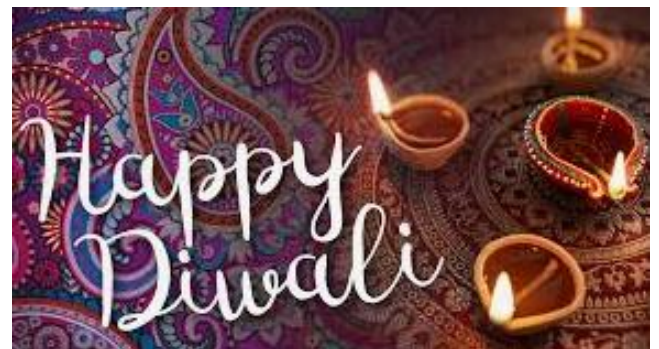
Children in Need
